- Sanction No: 6-150
- Format: Prelim/Finals meet open to athletes with 14 year old A times. Finals to include top 16 from prelims with warm-up to begin no sooner than 1 hour following prelims.

- Eligibility: Swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming or applicable FINA registration. No on-deck registration shall be permitted.
- Entry Deadlines: Entry acceptance period begins: Noon, Wednesday, November 15th, 2006 NO EARLIER PLEASE! Early entries will not be accepted! Team Manager event file will be available on CAT website by November 1st, 2006. Final entry deadline is 5:00 PM, Wednesday, November 29th, 2006.
- Event/Meet Limit: 3 events per day exclusive of relays/350 total athletes (selected on a first come first served basis). Please note that relays may be cancelled without refund subject to timeline constraints.
- Entry Fees: \$1.50 surcharge per swimmer
\$2.00 per individual event \$8.00 per relay

- Entries: Submit **YARD TIMES** only for seeding. Swimmers must meet time standards. No-times or substandard times may be scratched without notification or refund. Send entries on a disk using Hy-Tek Format OR via email. All entries must be followed up with confirming entry reports, either hard-copy or soft-copy via email. Teams with less than 5 swimmers may be entered on paper forms (no cards).
- Check-in: All events will be deck-seeded and over-swimmer starts will be used. Coaches are responsible for providing a positive check-in of swimmers ½ hour prior to start of meet each day. After the start of the meet, all scratches must be made 45 minutes prior to an event at the **Clerk Of Course** on deck. OSI scratch rules will be in effect.
- Facility: Competition Pool – Eight lanes, 7-ft, 25-yd lanes, 30-in. tilted blocks. Depth: 6 to 13 ft
- Warm-up Pool: Shallow end east of bulkhead open for continuous warmup/cooldown. Outdoor pool available during AM warm-ups on Saturday/Sunday.
- Seating: Air-conditioned, sound insulated, balcony seating for 270. Only those parents who are timing are allowed in the starting area. **SWIMMERS AND COACHES ONLY IN THE COMPETITION AREA OF THE POOL.**

Timing: Daktronics timing system, horn start, and finish touch pads. Results via electronic scoreboard. Names will appear as received in meet entries.

Pool Hours: Pool will be open from 7:00 AM until conclusion of the meet.

Meetings: Officials meeting will be held approximately 60 minutes prior to start of prelims. Coaches meeting 15 minutes prior to start of prelims.

Officials: This meet has been approved as an N2/N3 Qualifying Meet. Please find a Request for Evaluation form specifically for this meet posted at www.oregonswimming.org. All persons wishing to be evaluated for N2 or N3 must complete this form. If evaluation for Chief Judge, Starter, or Referee is desired, you must submit this form directly to Meet Referee, Bruce Ludwig. Submit the form using contact information on the Oregon Swimming web site, or on the Request for Evaluation form, no later than December 1, 2006. Requests for Evaluation for Stroke & Turn Judges are preferred in advance, but may be accepted on deck if evaluation slots are available. The number of evaluation slots is limited. The actual number is dependant upon the mix of certification levels for which evaluation is requested and the number of evaluators available. All persons wishing to be evaluated for advancement to N2 or N3 must work all four sessions on Saturday and Sunday.

All officials are welcome and encouraged to work this meet, even if evaluation is not requested. However, to be considered for assignment as Chief Judge, Starter, or Referee, a Request for Evaluation must be used. Simply write on the form "No Evaluation Requested." Officials requesting evaluation will be given priority in making assignments for these positions.

This meet will be a training meet for officials, and is guaranteed to be fun to work. Newer officials should NOT be intimidated by this process as the meet will be a good experience for all.

Timers: Each team will be given lane-timing assignments. Sign-ups will be available behind the competition area.

Concessions: Cold items (non-grilled i.e. bagels, granola bars) available during preliminary sessions Saturday and Sunday.

No OVERNIGHT CAMPING. Multiple parking lots, shared with adjacent school, are available for RVs for day use only. There will be no outside toilet facilities. Camping is available at Benton County Fairgrounds (541) 757-1521, and KOA Campground off Hwy. 34 (541) 967-8521.

No tobacco products, alcohol, or glass containers are allowed in the pool facility. Current Oregon Swimming Safety Guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect. No parents or non-competing children are allowed in the competition area (swimmers, timers, officials and coaches only).
